Points Worth Contemplating

1. God is with you through the presence and power of His Holy Spirit.
2. Follow the good example of our parents
3. Do not worship images or icons or trendsetters of this world
4. If our parents are called by God, seek their God
5. Obey God commandments
6. Do not follow the practices of this world
7. Parents, do not **ever** underestimate the impact that your parenting, good and bad, has on your children.
8. God will bless our obedience
9. Are you deeply committed to the way of the Lord?
10. What are you willing to remove from your life to be more pleasing to God?
11. Are you showing Godly Leadership?
12. How committed are we to teaching those under our leadership, particularly our children, the truth of God out of the Bible?
13. Walking with God in this life is challenging
14. In our enthusiasm, particularly regarding our work or our friends, we can overcommit
15. We can make that mistake at times when the work we are trying to do overshadows the work God has called us to do.
16. Be careful. You may not know what god your friend, colleague, or co-worker is following.
17. Do we side with family, friends, or co-workers over the way of the Lord?
18. Wrong is wrong, even if the odds are 400+ to 1!
19. **"I will say only what my God says"**! How about us? Do we have that depth of conviction and courage?
20. It is more than having God's Holy Spirit available to us; we must yield to the leading of the Holy Spirit—we must not grieve the Holy Spirit!
21. Even if we have made the wrong decision and facing great fear, turn to God and CRY OUT....FATHER, FATHER!
22. Teens, young adults, adults, please have the courage to step away...and step away early when the Spirit of God working with you lets you know that you should be going in a different direction.
23. Do not discount the active presence of evil spiritual power at play in the lives, words, and actions of others and even ourselves.
24. It's not too late to Abandon Ship!

25. Don't push out of your mind things of God that have entered through the Spirit of God.
26. Understanding God's plan, that Jesus Christ, the Messiah, is to REND or SPLIT the heavens, come down to this earth, and establish the government of God by divine force, is a revelation into our heart by God's Holy Spirit.
27. Be willing to wait on God!
28. Don't forget the ways of God!
29. Be willing to wash out the filthy rags!
30. Holding on and pursuing God requires work—and God wants to see that desire in us.
31. We are simply clay in the hands of the Master Potter; remain in His hand.
32. God's word and purpose WILL stand!
33. Even if we walk all the way down the road to disaster, don't throw in the towel on the truth of God; prepare your heart to seek God and repent!
34. The Lord will hear us,
35. Sometimes, He will come immediately to our aid and deliver us completely,
36. Sometimes, He may deliver us, but we will still have a situation to deal with,
37. Sometimes, He may spare our life, but our future trajectory is impacted,
38. Sometimes, He may choose not to intervene, and we have to walk through it all—and face the full physical brunt of our decision of not yielding to the urging of the Spirit of the Lord.
39. You do not judge for man but for the LORD, who *is* with you in the judgment
40. You shall act in the fear of the LORD, faithfully and with a loyal heart
41. You shall warn others, lest they trespass against the LORD and wrath come upon you and your brethren/your family.
42. Take to the ministry, leaders, and teacher before you
43. Behave courageously, and the LORD will be with the good
44. By yielding to the power of God's Holy Spirit, incredible miracles were possible. God HIMSELF fought for them. God Himself had given them victory. God Himself gave them rest.
45. The Holy Spirit helps us to be what God wants us to be, but we have to yield ourselves to it.
46. The Holy Spirit helps us when we fail to uphold the standard of God's righteousness, but we must learn from it
47. The Holy Spirit helps us to be victorious many times throughout life, but we cannot be forgetful
48. The Holy Spirit helps us with our children, but as they become adults, they must yield its urging, it will not make them yield
49. God, through the power of God's Holy Spirit, is present and available to work in your life, every moment, of every day, in every circumstance!
