A MATTER OF PERSONAL CHOICE, NOT SIN!

Philippians 2:12–13 (NKJV)

12 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; **13** for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for *His* good pleasure.

- The topics of vaccinations is not trivial matter
- Our health and how we care for our bodies is important to God
- Our individual faith in God does come into play
- What God's Word says does matters

At the end of the day there will be varying opinions and decisions that each of us will make. That is the same with all matter of life and health.

A MATTER OF PERSONAL CHOICE, NOT SIN!

- Receiving a vaccination is strictly a personal decision and is not of itself a sin.

1 John 3:4 (NKJV) 4 *Whoever commits sin also commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness.*

The concern surrounds the ingredients in the vaccine or the process in making the vaccine, and if the vaccine or the process involved includes/included ingredients that are contrary to God's food laws or unconscionable in other ways, i.e. human cell strains, or fetal cells or tissue.

The challenge is in knowing what the absolute truth is regarding the ingredients and research procedures.

A good question to ask:

If you knew the absolute truth regarding the ingredients/procedures, either way, what decision would you make accordingly?

A MATTER OF PERSONAL CHOICE, NOT SIN!

- The Church encourages members to gather information from reputable sources in order to make wise decisions.
 - ...almost all medical procedures also include a degree of risk for each individual.
 - ...it is the responsibility of each member to learn the pros and cons—weighing the benefits versus the risks—before electing to receive *any* specific medical procedure or vaccination.

STEWARDS OF OUR BODIES AND CONSCIENCE BEFORE GOD

- The Church also teaches that our bodies are the temple of God's Spirit and that we are to glorify God in our Bodies

I Corinthians 3:16 (NKJV) 16 Do you not know that you are the temple of God and *that* the Spirit of God dwells in you?

I Corinthians 6:19–20 (NKJV) 19 Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit ~~who is~~ which is in you, ~~whom~~ that you have from God, and you are not your own? **20** For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

- Whether or not we choose to receive vaccinations, a more important question is, how are we taking care of the body that God created for us?

That statement does not eliminate the fact that vaccinations are important, it is a statement of balance.

WHATEVER IS NOT OF FAITH IS SIN

- The Church also teaches that whatever is not of faith is sin (Romans 14:23)

Romans 14:22–23 (NKJV) 22 Do you have faith? Have *it* to yourself before God. Happy *is* he who does not condemn himself in what he approves. **23** But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because *he does not eat* from faith; for whatever *is* not from faith is sin.

- We are to trust God, through Christ and His stripes, for our healing (Isaiah 53:5; I Peter 2:24).

Isaiah 53:5 (NKJV) 5 But He *was* wounded for our transgressions, *He was* bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace *was* upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

I Peter 2:24 (NKJV) 24 who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.

- It is therefore up to each of us to know what does—and does not—truly violate our conscience before God.

WHATEVER IS NOT OF FAITH IS SIN

- ...after learning all one can about the pros and cons of a specific vaccination (including benefits, risks, side-effects, ingredients, etc.), what one member may judge to be acceptable to receive into his or her body may be a violation of conscience for another. One member may choose to receive every suggested vaccination, while another may feel comfortable receiving only selected vaccinations or none at all.
- Within God's Church no member should judge another for choosing to either receive or avoid vaccinations.
- We must allow others to make their own choices before God.

REQUIRED / EXEMPTED

- Members who work in health-care environments, for example, are often required to receive a vaccination. The only options are to receive the vaccination or find employment elsewhere.
- There are other situations when exemptions are permitted. However, such exemptions may vary according to state, municipality, school district, etc. Members who desire to take advantage of an exemption must find out what the specific allowances are for their state or locality.
- Even in the employment world, an exemption will sometimes be granted for a “required” vaccination, based on one or more criteria. Being conscientiously opposed to vaccinations is a primary example of exemption criteria in many situations.

EXEMPTION LETTER

- *If* a member desires exemption from vaccination, and *if* the reason for seeking exemption is based on sincerely held religious principles, and *if* the member's employer (or school, etc.) requires confirmation from the member's Church, then a local pastor can provide a letter that confirms:
- That the individual is a member of the Church of God, a Worldwide Association.
- That the Church supports the following scriptural principles:
 - We are to glorify God in our body and spirit, which are God's (I Corinthians 6:20).
 - We trust God, through Christ and His stripes, for our healing (Isaiah 53:5; I Peter 2:24).
 - Whatever is not of faith is sin and must be avoided (Romans 14:23).

EXEMPTION LETTER

- That if, in light of these Scriptures, a member cannot in good faith before God submit to immunizations or inoculations without violating his or her conscience (and thereby sinning), he or she may take advantage of exemption laws or provisions that honor such as a matter of conscience.
- Of course, the member should first talk with his or her pastor sufficiently for the pastor to be able to confirm—to an employer or school official—that the member's religious convictions on the subject of vaccinations are sincerely held and that going against those convictions would violate a tenet of Scripture (Romans 14:23).

STATE OF FLORIDA

Exemption from Required Immunizations

[Download Vaccine Responsibilities to Your Community Flyers](#)

Private health care providers may grant a Temporary Medical Exemption (TME), documented on the Form DH 680, Florida Certification of immunization, for those who are in the process of completing any necessary immunizations. The TME requires an expiration date after which the exemption is no longer valid, and the immunizations must be completed before or at that time.

A Permanent Medical Exemption, documented on the Form DH 680, can be granted if a child cannot be fully immunized due to medical reasons. In this case, the child's physician must state in writing, the reasons for exemption based on valid clinical reasoning or evidence.

Form DH 681, Religious Exemption From Immunization, is issued if immunizations are in conflict with the religious tenets and practices of the child's parent or guardian. This exemption is issued by a County Health Department (CHD) and based on established religious beliefs or practices only.



- o Fiction: The COVID-19 vaccines were developed using fetal tissue
- o Fact: NO vaccines are developed using fetal tissue. Some vaccines are developed using cell cultures, but current mRNA COVID-19 vaccines were not developed in that way.

- Animals have been used in the industrialized production of human vaccines since vaccine farms were established to harvest cowpox virus from calves in the late 1800s. From that point, and through the first half of the 20th century, most vaccines would continue to be developed with the use of animals, either by growing pathogens in live animals or by using animal cells.
- The first licensed vaccine made with the use of a human cell strain was the adenovirus vaccine used by the military in the late 1960s. Later, other vaccines were developed in human cell strains, most notably the rubella vaccine developed by Stanley Plotkin, MD, at the Wistar Institute in Philadelphia.

Current Vaccines Developed Using Human Cell Strains

The vaccines below were developed using either the WI-38 or the MRC-5 cell strains.

- Hepatitis A vaccines [VAQTA/Merck, Havrix/GlaxoSmithKline, and part of Twinrix/GlaxoSmithKline]
- Rubella vaccine [MERUVAX II/Merck, part of MMR II/Merck, and ProQuad/Merck]
- Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine [Varivax/Merck, and part of ProQuad/Merck]
- Zoster (shingles) vaccine [Zostavax/Merck]
- Adenovirus Type 4 and Type 7 oral vaccine [Barr Labs] *
- Rabies vaccine [IMOVAX/Sanofi Pasteur] *

**Vaccine not routinely given*

Researchers have estimated that vaccines made in WI-38 and its derivatives have prevented nearly 11 million deaths and prevented (or treated, in the example of rabies) 4.5 billion cases of disease.

Several vaccines currently available in the United States were developed using animal cell strains, primarily using cells from African green monkeys. These include vaccines against Japanese encephalitis, rotavirus, polio, and smallpox. Of these, only rotavirus and polio vaccines are routinely given.

Do Vaccines Contain Aborted Fetal Tissue?

Several common vaccines are made by growing the necessary viruses in fetal embryo fibroblast cells. These cells originally came from tissue obtained from two fetuses that were legally and electively aborted in the early 1960s.

The same cells have continued to grow in a laboratory and are still used to make vaccines today. No additional fetal cells have been harvested since then, but the topic is controversial because of the original source.¹

COVID-19 Vaccines & Fetal Cell Lines

Some of the COVID-19 vaccines being studied in clinical trials use cells originally isolated from fetal tissue (often referred to as fetal cells) in various stages of vaccine development and manufacturing.

Historical fetal cell lines were derived in the 1960's and 1970's from two elective abortions that were not performed for the purpose of vaccine development. Fetal cell lines were used to create vaccines for diseases such as hepatitis A, rubella, and rabies. The fetal cells lines being used to produce some of the potential COVID-19 vaccines are from two sources:

- *HEK-293: A kidney cell line that was isolated from a terminated fetus in 1972*
- *PER.C6: A retinal cell line that was isolated from a terminated fetus in 1985*

Any vaccine that relies on these historic cell lines will not require new abortions.

Are the Pfizer and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines developed using fetal cell lines?

The mRNA COVID-19 vaccines produced by Pfizer and Moderna **do not require the use of any fetal cell cultures in order to manufacture (produce) the vaccine.**

Early in the development of mRNA vaccine technology, fetal cells were used for “proof of concept” (to demonstrate how a cell could take up mRNA and produce the SARS-CoV-2 spike protein) or to characterize the SARS-CoV-2 spike protein.

The Pfizer and Moderna vaccines were found to be **ethically uncontroversial** by the pro-life policy organization [the Charlotte Lozier Institute](#). Further, Brian Kane, senior director of ethics for the Catholic Health Association of the United States, in an interview for the [America: The Jesuit Review](#) stated: “In terms of the moral principles of being concerned about the use of any pharmaceuticals that were developed from aborted fetuses, that is certainly an issue that we all want to be cognizant of and try to avoid their use. With that in mind, the **Pfizer and Moderna COVID vaccines that are coming out are not even tainted with that moral problem.**”

With that in mind, the Pfizer and Moderna COVID vaccines that are coming out are not even tainted with that moral problem.”
